Access the Flickr website and sign up for a new account. If you already have a Yahoo email account, you will be able to use your Yahoo login credentials. Visit http://flickr.com and click SIGN UP:

IMPORTANT: Remember when you are using a SHARED computer to ALWAYS log off your account, so others cannot access it as you!

The best way to store, search, sort and share your photos.






Use the online Flickr Help resources. In the upper right corner of the Flickr site, click **HELP** for more information.




PRIVACY NOTE: When you upload photos to Flickr, you specify whether you want everyone to be able to view images, or a limited group which you identify as family or friends.



On your Flickr HOME page you can access:

- New Flickr mail messages
- Flickr News
- A link to upload new photos
- A link to your photos, photos from friends / family, and everyone's photos






Many Flickr users share their images under Creative Commons licenses. To conduct a Creative Commons Flickr search, at the bottom of any Flickr webpage beside EXPLORE click CREATIVE COMMONS:






The most permissive Creative

To UPLOAD and share your own images on Flickr, you have several choices. From the YOU menu item on any Flickr page, click UPLOAD PHOTOS:





Upload images from your computer like you would send an email attachment. Alternatively, click UPLOADING TOOLS to download and use programs that make it easier to upload multiple pictures at the same time.

Add TAGS for your images. TAGS do NOT have any spaces, and identify what your image is about. TAGS permit the creation of "folksonomies" which organize content dynamically.


UPLOAD

Set privacy settings before you click UPLOAD. Make sure you have permission to share images. If you're sharing images of your own children or grandchildren, it is a good idea to NOT make those images public.



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Before uploading you can also set a safety level and content type, and choose to hide the images from public searches.





Under GROUPS in the top menu bar of Flickr, search for and join one or more groups to which you'd like to contribute. The direct link for the OKDC project is:

- * Safe Content suitable for a global, public audience
- * Moderate If you're not sure whether your content is suitable for a global, public audience but you think that it doesn't need to be restricted per se, this category is for you
- * Restricted This is content you probably wouldn't show to your mum, and definitely shouldn't be seen by kids
